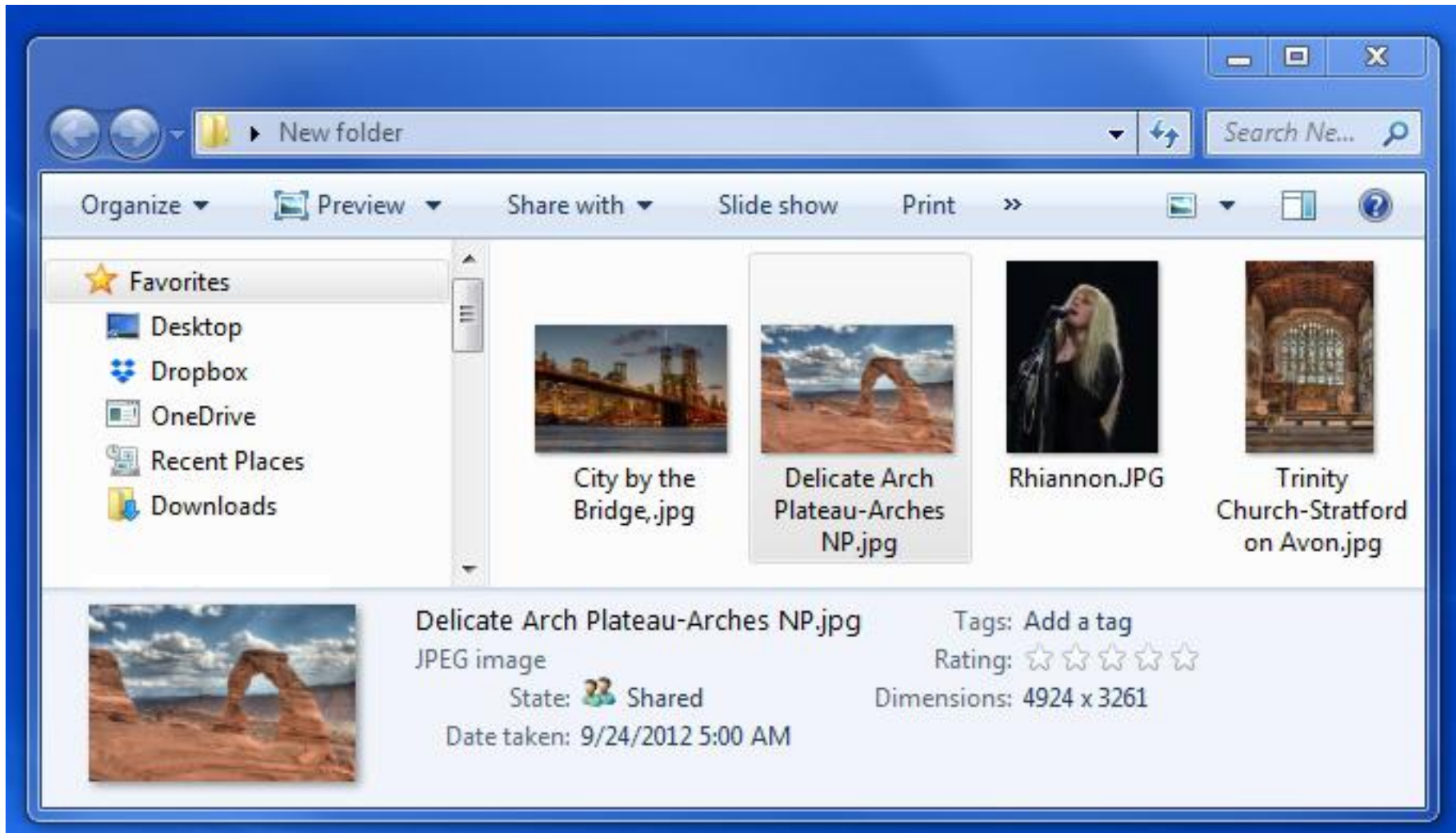


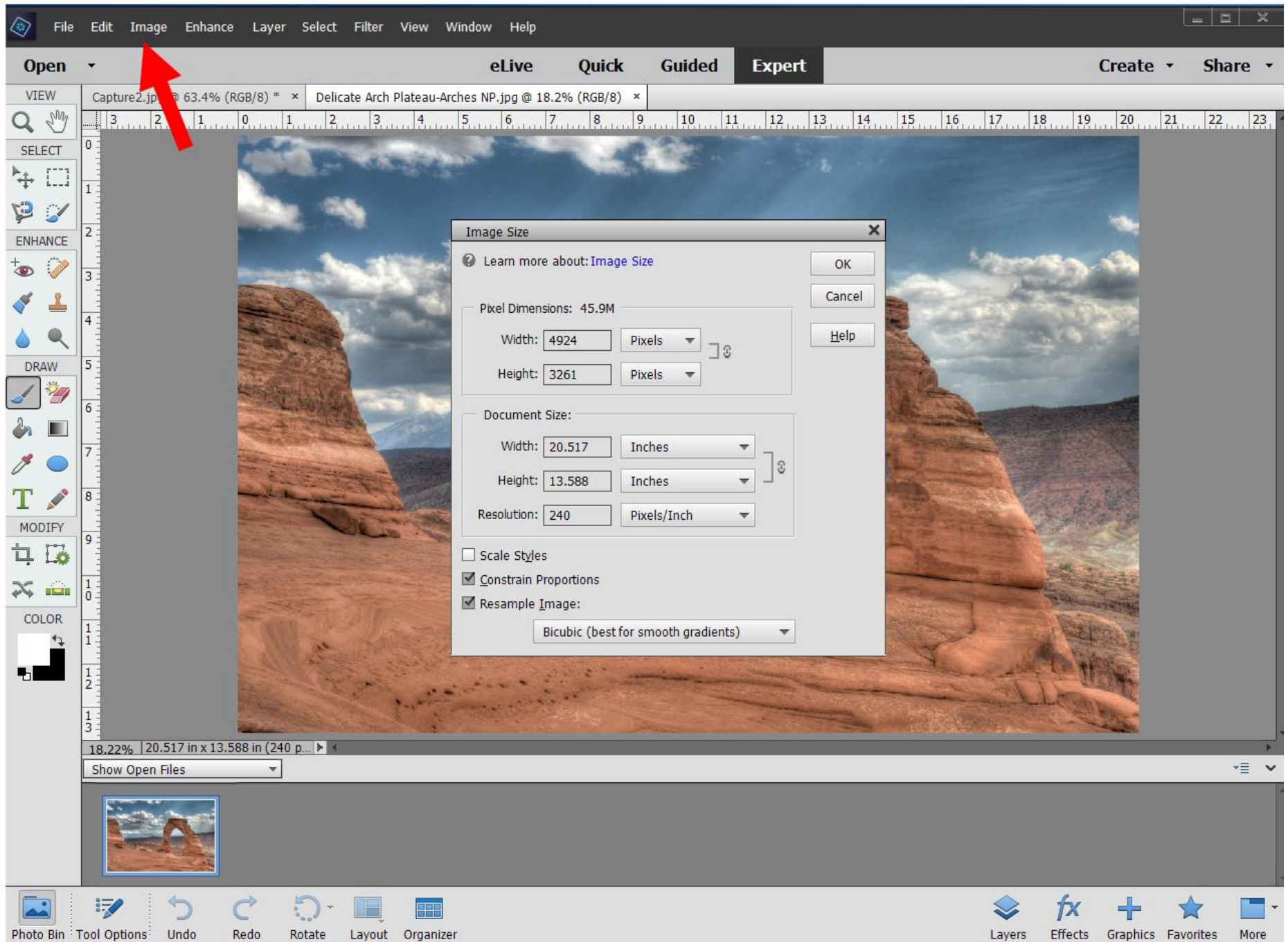
## Resizing your Photos for submission to Fredericksburg Photo Club Critiques or Galleries

If you have Adobe Photoshop or Photoshop Elements you can use this procedure to resize your photos



Open the folder that contains your photos.

Right click on the one you want to resize and, in the dropdown panels that appear, select **OPEN WITH > ADOBE PHOTOSHOP ELEMENTS**



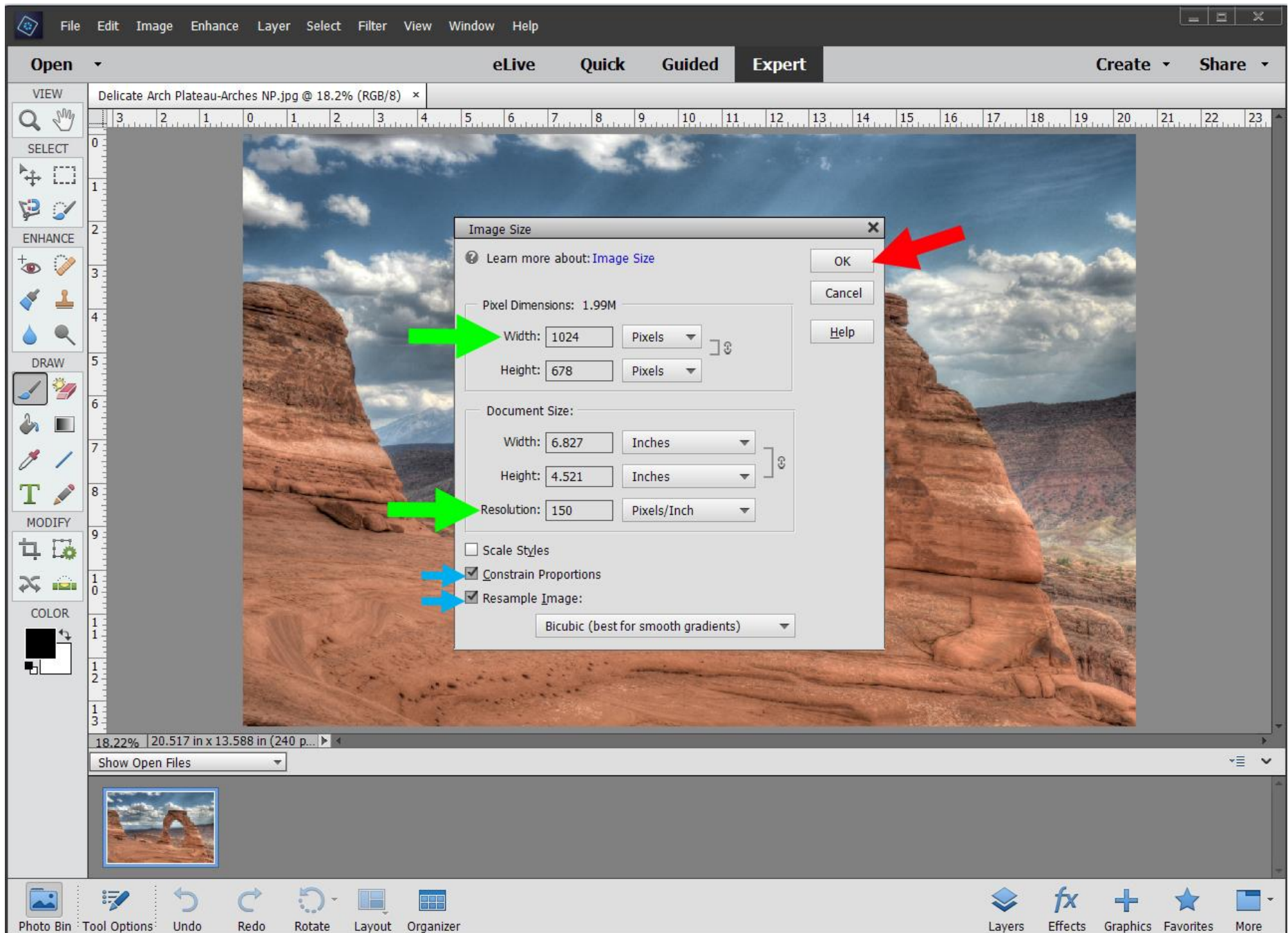
A new window opens showing your image in the Adobe Photoshop workspace

On the top menu bar **select IMAGE > RESIZE > IMAGE SIZE** from the dropdown panels

Another window opens showing the current size of the image ( *4924 pixels wide, 3261 high at 240 pixels per inch* )

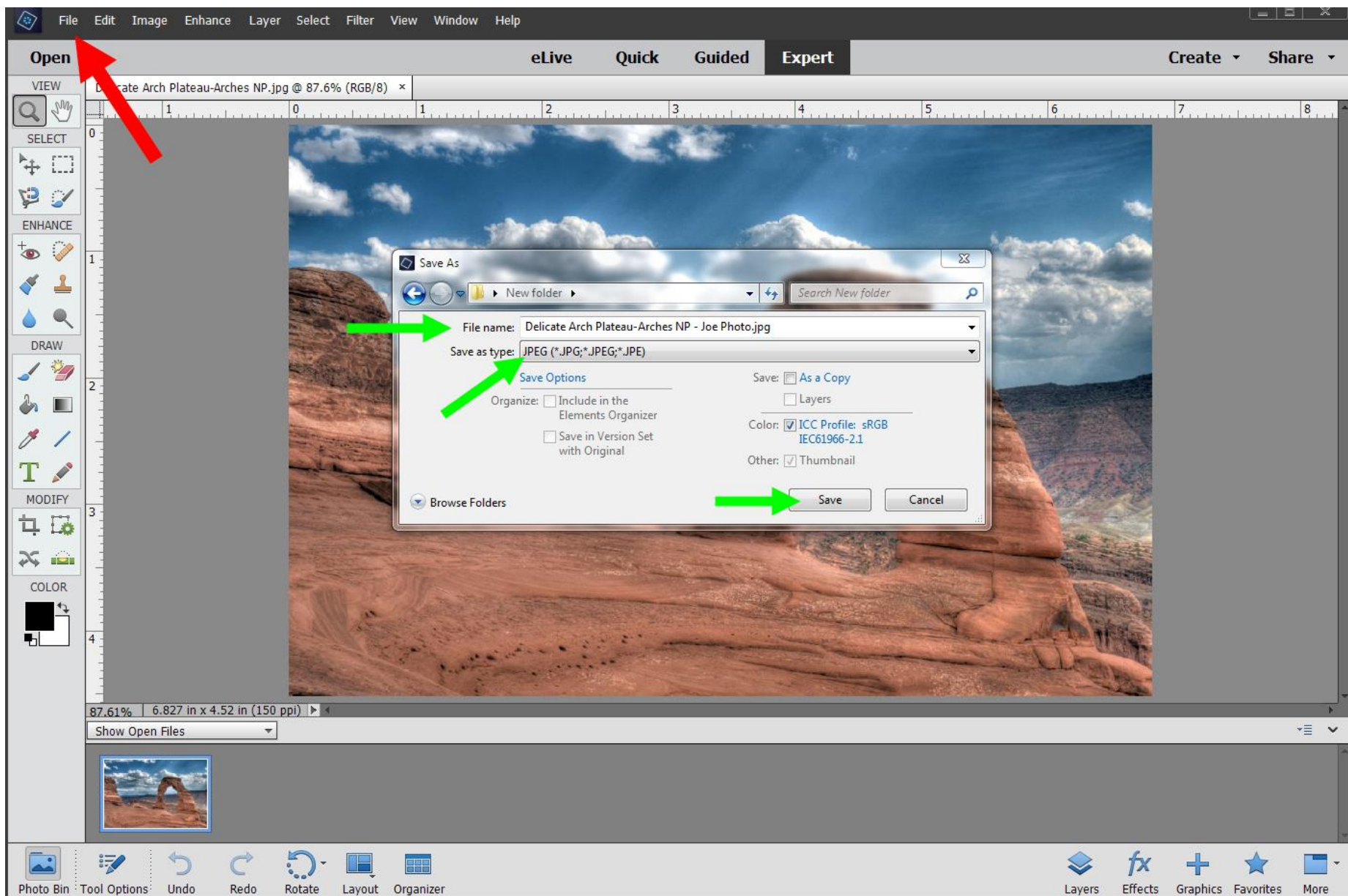


# Here's where the magic happens!



Change the number in **Resolution to 150** and in **Width to 1024**

Make sure the boxes **Constrain Proportions** and **Resample Image** are checked (*This is what keeps the correct proportion between width and height*) and finally click **OK**



Now click **FILE > SAVE AS** in the dropdown panels

Make sure to append your name after the image title so you won't replace your original image with this smaller size version. Click **SAVE**.

**That's it, you have now resized your image. Congratulations!**
