- 9. What are some common photography pitfalls?
- 10. What are your favorite settings?
- 11. What kind of tools do you use for post-processing? What's your workflow like"?
- 12. Out of all your photos, which one is your favorite? Why?
- 13. How do you stay focused on your art?
- 14. What do you think about social media for photographers?
- 15. Whose work has influenced you most?

These are great questions that are frequently asked. Starting in January 2024, I will be periodically asking one of these questions in an email to all members and using answers in the newsletters
